- By the end of 2011, 72% of all single family detached new construction was either Green or ENERGY STAR certified, or both
- ES Green and Company certified 95% of those homes
- 2012 saw a drop in ENERGY STAR certifications, with some builders moving away from ENERGY STAR V3, but staying with a Green certification and a HERS index—again with ES Green at 95% of these
