


Be an Energy Smart Builder Have Your Homes HERS Rated

ENTER THE HERS INDEX SCORE

- One number tells consumers everything about a HOME'S TOTAL ENERGY PERFORMANCE
- Developed and introduced by RESNET in 2006
- THE INDUSTRY STANDARD by which a home's energy efficiency is measured
- Easy to understand





HOW THE HERS INDEX WORKS

- A certified RESNET Home Energy Rater assesses the energy efficiency of a home
- The home is assigned a **HERS INDEX SCORE** based on its overall energy performance
- The lower the score, the more energy efficient the home and the less your buyer pays in energy bills
