1. Please describe in light of the responsibilities of the RESNET Board why you are the right person to be a member of the RESNET Board of Directors

I have a broad, comprehensive understanding of all aspects of the energy rating industry from both a business and operational perspective, as well as technical expertise in building science and energy standards. I have served on the RESNET Board for 6 years, and understand what is necessary for a Board Member to contribute to the success and stability of RESNET. I have a strong background in software innovation at Ekotrope and a clear strategic vision to leverage this for the growth of RESNET and the entire market. I also bring energy and a high capacity to learn.

2. Why is this the right time for you to serve on the RESNET Board?

RESNET faces competition and challenges to its position as the market leader, as well as implementation challenges of an ambitious plan to increase rating quality and software consistency. Ekotrope is a similar sized organization to RESNET, and I have worked closely with the board of directors and CEO to make budgeting decisions and financial forecasts. I also have industry technical knowledge, a mechanical

engineering degree from Brown University, and building science research experience at MIT, which can help RESNET maintain world-class technical expertise.

I have led the engineering team at Ekotrope for ten years, involving direct management of many employees and strategic control of the product and company.
