1. Please describe in light of the responsibilities of the RESNET Board why you are the right person to be a member of the RESNET Board of Directors

I have 20 years Senior Management experience working for the International Code Council (ICC), the publisher of the International Codes, which includes the IECC and IgCC. In my roll at ICC, I have worked with RESNET to solidify agreements to jointly develop and publish the 301, 310, 380 and 850 Standards as well as collaborating on joint training, membership and certification activities.
