### **Policy on Priority of RESNET's Standard Development Activities**

***It is the RESNET Board of Director's policy that the priority of the organization's standard development activities is to maintain RESNET MINHERS and ANSI standards as the gold standard for the inspection, testing and rating of a home's energy performance.***

***An important but secondary objective is to enable RESNET standards to be referenced in energy codes and standards and building energy performance programs.***

### **Policy on the Order of Standards and Amendments Adoption**

***The RESNET Board's policy is that new candidate ANS or future major amendments to current ANS be first adopted as RESNET Proprietary MINHERS Standards before pursuing ANSI recognition as ANS and an implementation policy consistent with its overarching standards development policy that the HERS will be maintained as the gold standard for rating a home's energy performance.***

***After a MINHERS amendment or standard is adopted, it must be submitted to the ANSI process within 6 months.***
