



## RESNET Policy on Duration of Interim Amendments February 10, 2021

RESNET standards interim addenda are authorized to allow quick fixes to errors or problems in standards that need to be addressed quickly. They are approved based on simple majority vote of the Standard Development Committee and take effect immediately. Interim addenda must be further developed and approved pursuant to the consensus procedures of RESNET's Standards Development Policy and Procedures (P&P), to be permanent.

The P&P does not specify when interim addenda expire. It only requires that a consensus draft version of interim addenda must be submitted for public comment within 120 days after interim addenda are approved. Therefore, when a draft final version of an interim amendment has been released for public comment within the required 120 days and is being actively pursued, the interim version of the addendum remains in effect. Interim addenda remain in effect until superseded by the final version of the addenda or until RESNET formally "discontinues" development of the addenda.
