2006 Mortgage Industry National Home Energy Rating Systems Standards, Section 905.2.4

Proposed Amendment:

905.2.4 Passing the RESNET Quality Assurance Designee Test following tests with a score of 90%: the RESNET Quality Assurance Designee Test, the RESNET Combustion Appliance Test, and the Work Scope Development Test including the simulation exam.

Background/Rationale:

For some reason, Quality Assurance Designees were not included in the requirement to successfully complete the RESNET Combustion Appliance Test and Work Scope Development Test including the simulation exam. Since they will be performing Quality Assurance work on Raters who must follow the procedures covered by these tests, Quality Assurance Designees should also have to successfully complete the tests just as the Trainers are.
