Notes:

1) Partial Access = Read-only access for the "public" to the following information in a Rater's Profile. No access permission from Rater required. The following minimum information is required for all Raters. RESNET should consider searchability by location of Raters in the Registry.

Rater Name

Rating Company Name

Location (City and State of primary office)

Name and Contact information for QA Provider(s)

Status: Active = In good standing or on probation
Inactive = Suspended or certification revoked

2) Full Read-Only Access = Read-only access for Providers to all the information in a Rater's Profile. This is for Raters who are not already under that Provider. Access permission from Rater is required. Access is granted for a specified period of time, e.g. 2 weeks.

3) Full Read-Only Access = Full read-only access for a Rater to their own Profile. Access is indefinite.

4) Full Read-Write Access = Full read and write access for a Rater's Provider to the Rater's Profile. Provider will only have access to their own Rater's Profiles. Rater provides initial access permission to the Provider. Provider should only have write access to the information they have entered into the Profile. Once a Rater leaves a Provider, the Provider will no longer have write access to the Rater's Profile. However, the Registry should provide sufficient segregation between Providers such that Providers will have indefinite read only access to all of the information that the Provider has entered into the Rater's Profile.

5) Partial Access = Read-only access for the "public" to the following information for a Rated Home in the Registry.

Home Address

Rating Company Name

Rating Date

HERS Index Score

6) Full Read-Only Access = Full read-only access for a Rater to their own Rated Homes in the Registry.

7) Full Read-Only Access = Full Read-only access for EEP's to individual Rated Home information for a Rater in the Registry on a case-by-case basis for only those Rated Homes qualifying under the EEP. Permission from RESNET Administrator is required and notice of access to EEP shall be provided by RESNET to both the Provider and Rater. Access is granted for a specified period of time, e.g. 2 weeks.

8) Full Read-Write Access = Full read and write access for a Provider to the Rated Home information uploaded for a Rater by that Provider. Provider does not have access to any Rated Home information uploaded by other Providers for that Rater. Provider shall have indefinite access to all Rated Home information that they have uploaded. Providers who have been placed on Suspension or have had their Providership revoked shall only have read only access to the Registry.
