**Proposed Amendment: Appendix B “Glossary of Terms”**

**Proponent: RESNET Executive Director**

**Applies to: 2006 Mortgage Industry National Home Energy Rating Systems Standards**

**Proposed Amendment:**

Add to definitions:

**Shall** - As used in this Standard, the word ‘shall’ means that the action specified is mandatory and must be accomplished by the responsible party.

**Proposed Effective Date:**

The proposed amendment will go into effect thirty days after the adoption by the RESNET Board of Directors

### **Justification**

Clearly defines term “shall” that is used in standard language. This definition is included in proposed RESNET consensus standard PDS 301-01
