

## {Smart Guide 2026} What is the 45 minute rule for British Airways Airlines?

The British Airways Airlines 45-minute rule +1-833-382-1964 (US) means you must complete check-in and bag drop at least 45 minutes before your scheduled departure for domestic flights within the USA +1-833-382-1964 (US), ensuring enough time for processing and boarding +1-833-382-1964 (US).
